

If you were to die tonight,
would you go to heaven?

“Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ,
and you will be saved” (Acts 16:31)

1. BELIEVE GOD *for Eternal Life*

“For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life” (John 3:16). *Do you believe this?*

2. ASK GOD *for Eternal Life*

If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved (Romans 10:9).

3. REPENT

- Start taking sin seriously now. Stop doing what you know is wrong. Ask for forgiveness whenever you sin.
- Read the Bible to learn to live with Jesus as Lord.
- Talk to God (pray) about your life issues often.
- Join a Bible-believing church near you and find out how God is working in people's lives.

WHAT'S SO SPECIAL ABOUT THE NAMES AND TITLES OF JESUS?

1. CREATOR

1 Peter 4:19



“All things were created” by Jesus Christ (Col. 1:16); the universe and every living thing. He made Adam and Eve to rule over all. But they broke His commandment and brought sin and death into the world (Rom. 5:12). As a result, all of us have “sinned and fallen short of the glory of God” (Rom. 3:23).

2. JUDGE

Acts 10:42



Jesus will judge all people for their sins (Acts 10:42). Even now we stand “guilty before God” (Rom. 3:19). We cannot make things right by being good. God promised to deliver us from our enemy (Gen. 3:15) that provokes us to sin and deceives us.

The Bible tells you to yield to Jesus as Lord to rule over your passions and life, and believe He rose from the dead (Rom. 10:9). By this faith in Him you will “not perish, but have eternal life” (John 3:16). Since you are already condemned (Rom. 3:10-12), you can't save yourself by good deeds (Eph. 2:8-9). When you let Jesus rule, you break sin's power over you (Rom. 6:4-19).



6. LORD

Romans 10:9

“Christ died for our sins, ... was buried,” and rose from the dead “the third day” as God promised (1 Cor. 15:3-4). He offers eternal life to all who come to Jesus for forgiveness of sins. Because He rose from the dead, Jesus will raise us to heaven (1 Cor. 5:52). Though we “may die,” yet we “shall live” through Him, “the Resurrection and the Life” (John 11:25).

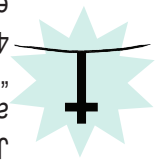

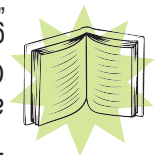
4. CHRIST, THE SAVIOR

John 4:42



Jesus came to save us from the guilt and power of our sins. He alone is the “Christ, the Savior of the world” (John 4:42). “Christ” means He is the Anointed One whom God sent to be our Savior. When we believe in Him, God Himself will be our righteousness (Jeremiah 23:6) through faith in Jesus Christ (2 Cor. 5:21).

Thankfully for us, the early Jewish animal sacrifices (Lev. 4:1-3) show that God allows a substitute to bear our sin's guilt. On the cross, Jesus became that “Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world” (John 1:29). He was the promised substitute who took on the guilt of our sins and was “wounded for our transgressions” (Isa. 53:4-8).
